Newsletter print costs

The Councillors had received an email from Roger Young regarding the cost of producing a hard copy of the Newsletter. It was noted that the parishioners had welcomed the return of the printed copy and the council could no longer expect Roger to continue this service without payment of his expenses. It was agreed that Roger should invoice the parish for his expenses. The Parish Clerk was asked to include a sum of £100 within next year's budget to cover these costs.

Defibrillator

Funds of £1,000 had been received via the Tesco Bags of Help scheme. The Clerk had researched the equipment and the EofEAS had recommended the Gold Pack via Cardiac Science at a total cost of £1,640 plus VAT. This would include a heated external cabinet. The Parish Clerk was asked to contact EofEAS to clarify exactly what would be provided for the money and whether this would be fitted as part of the price.

Business Extra to the Agenda

Geoff Kilham asked the council if they had any comment to make about the new bridge markings. Both his wife and Richard Gray had experienced a clash of wing mirrors since the new road markings and neither were happy with the current markings. The parish would monitor the situation. Geoff also mentioned there were now no white lines where the road narrows at Anmer Road since the road had been resurfaced.
